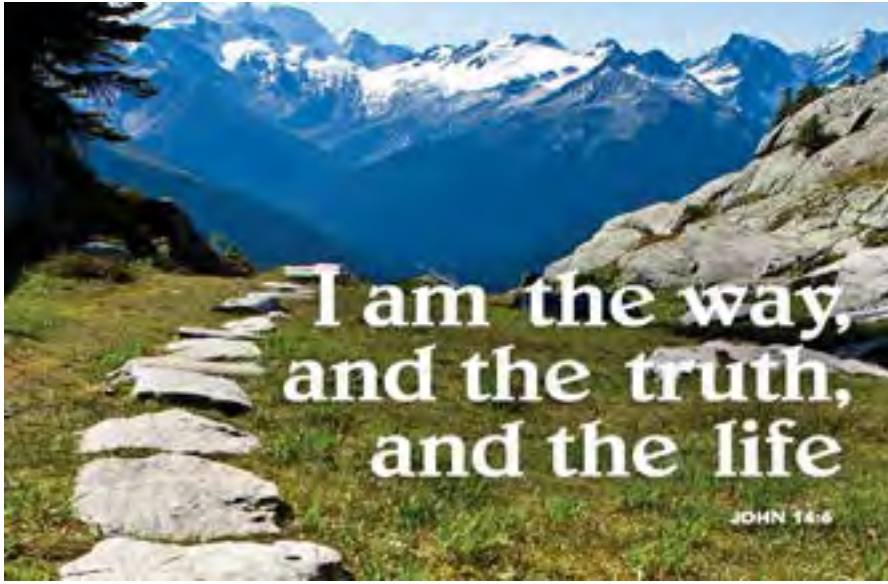

PARISH REGISTRATION

All Parishioners 18 years and older are urged to register at the Church Office. The Parish is often expected to provide proof of Baptism, Confirmation, and other miscellaneous letters for individuals. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process by which people become members of the Roman Catholic Church. Sessions are held on Tuesday evenings at 6:00 pm. SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Please contact the priest 9-12 months in advance for pre-wedding counseling. A Wedding Handbook is available in the Parish Office which provides information on preparing for a Catholic marriage.

Pero sobre todo, ellos contaron lo que Dios había hecho por medio de ellos y que es importante en la vida de la comunidad. Escuchemos.

SEGUNDA LECTURA: APOCALIPSIS 21:1-5

En el libro del Apocalipsis, san Juan ve un cielo nuevo y una nueva tierra, que es la Iglesia triunfante. Ese triunfo comienza en la tierra. Dios convive con nosotros y espera el fin de nuestra noche en la tierra para llenarnos de alegría. Si participamos, si sentimos y vivimos con la Iglesia aquí, gozaremos en el cielo. Presten mucha atención a esta revelación.

EVANGELIO: JUAN 13:31-35

El evangelio de hoy es parte del discurso de despedida del Señor en la última Cena. Cristo fue glorificado a través de su pasión y muerte, lo mismo va a pasar con su Iglesia. Cristo nos da un nuevo mandamiento, el amor mutuo. Puestos de pie, entonamos el Aleluya y escuchamos la Buena Nueva.

Amar como Él nos ama

La comunidad cristiana es signo del cielo nuevo y de la tierra nueva de que habla la segunda lectura. Pero, ¿qué tipo de signo? ¿En qué se debe notar que somos la semilla de la nueva creación? La clave nos la da el Evangelio de Juan. Jesús está a punto de despedirse de sus discípulos y les deja un mandamiento nuevo que es como su testamento. Les dice que se amen unos a otros como Él les ha amado. Esa será la señal por la que conocerán que somos discípulos de Jesús. Así pues, lo más distintivo de los cristianos no es que nos reunamos los domingos para celebrar la misa. Tampoco el que tengamos una jerarquía con un papa, obispos y sacerdotes. Jesús no deseaba que fuésemos conocidos por ninguna de esas cosas. Jesús deseaba que los que no perteneciesen a nuestra comunidad nos conociesen por otra señal, más humilde si se quiere, pero más importante y mucho más humana: por el modo como nos tratamos unos a otros, por el modo como nos amamos y amamos a todos sin distinción. Jesús quería que nos amásemos como él nos había amado.

Ése es el signo que hará descubrir a los que no son cristianos que la comunidad cristiana es la semilla de un nuevo mundo. Porque sólo Dios es capaz de dar vida a ese amor fraterno que hace que todo se comparta y que todos vivan más en plenitud. Cuando los que no son cristianos nos vean amar de verdad, necesariamente han de pensar que Dios está presente en nuestra comunidad, porque las personas, por nuestras solas fuerzas, no podemos amar de esa manera.

La presencia de Dios está con nosotros. Y cuando le dejamos actuar en nuestros corazones, experimentamos que un amor mayor que nuestras fuerzas brota de dentro de nosotros. Es el amor de Dios. Es el amor que es signo de la tierra nueva y del cielo nuevo. Es, por ejemplo, el amor con que la madre Teresa de Calcuta amó a los enfermos y moribundos. Es el amor con que muchos padres aman a sus hijos. Sin medida, sin tiempo, sin límite, con absoluta generosidad.

Pero como no somos superiores a los demás, a los que no son cristianos, como cometemos errores y a veces nos hacemos daño unos a otros, hay una dimensión del amor que la comunidad cristiana debe saber vivir de una manera especial. Es la dimensión del perdón, de la reconciliación. Perdonar a los hermanos –y perdonarme– es una forma de amar que reconocer la limitación propia y la supera porque el amor va más allá de los límites que marca nuestra debilidad. Vivir el perdón y la reconciliación en la comunidad cristiana es la mejor forma de dar testimonio del amor que nos une.
