PARISH REGISTRATION

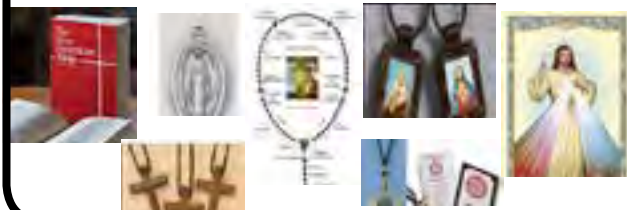
