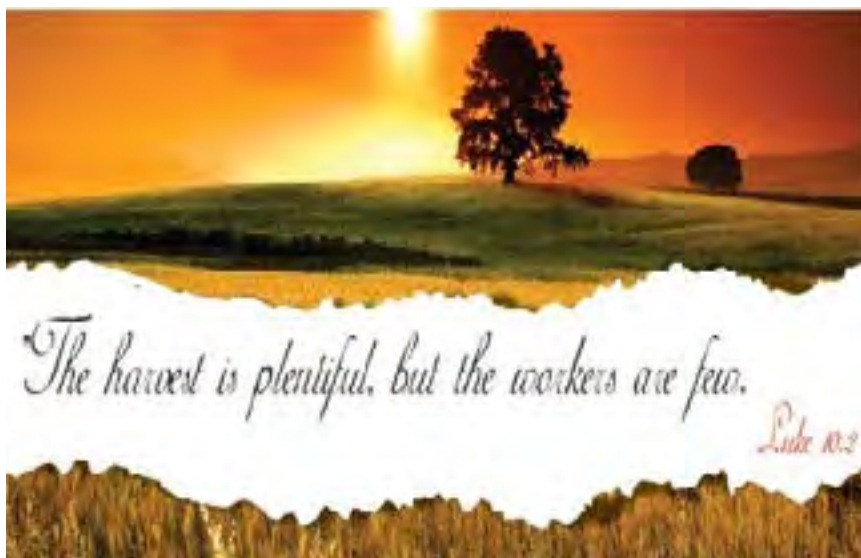

First Reading: Isaiah 66:10-14c Mother Jerusalem will gather her children.

Responsorial Psalm: 66 **“Let all the Earth cry out God with joy.”**

Second Reading: Galathians 6:14-18 I bear in my body the brand marks of Jesus.

Gospel: Luke 10:1-12,17-20 If people welcome you, bid them peace.

Every mass begins and ends with the sign of the cross. It is the most prominent sign of our identity as Christians. Saint Paul boasts in it, for it has transformed us all. The disciples bear it, sent out as lambs among wolves. The cross is our reminder that we should expect to suffer. But it is also a reminder of our redemption. Isaiah signs of the return to Jerusalem from exile, a redemption for Israel. Let us note the power of the cross as we listen to today’s reading.

PARISH REGISTRATION

All Parishioners 18 years and older are urged to register at the Church Office. The Parish is often expected to provide proof of Baptism, Confirmation, and other miscellaneous letters for individuals. This service is more easily and speedily rendered if the person is a registered, active and contributing member of our parish.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Please contact the priest 9-12 months in advance for pre-wedding counseling. A Wedding Handbook is available in the Parish Office which provides information on preparing for a Catholic marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

Please contact the parish at any time if you or a loved one are hospitalized, confined to home or a nursing facility, or have some other emergency, and would like to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

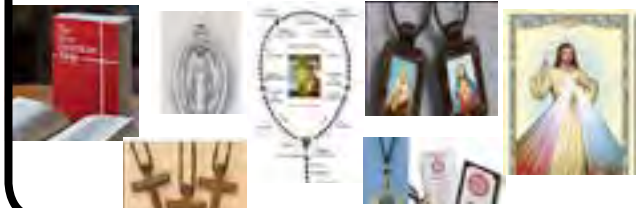
