FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

First Reading: Isaiah 40:1–5, 9-11 God’s glory shall be revealed

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 104 “O bless the Lord, my soul.”

Second Reading: Titus 2:11-14; 3:4-7 We are saved through the bath of rebirth

Gospel: Luke 3:15-16, 21-22 “You are my beloved Son”

Today’s first and second readings, no matter which ones are chosen, prepare us for Jesus’ baptism. Isaiah prophesied the Messiah, one who would bring peace and justice to the world. The early Christian community recognized the salvation they had received through baptism, salvation available to all. Then Saint Luke describes the Holy Spirit descending like a dove upon Jesus as he was praying after his baptism. As we listen, let us realize that the Holy Spirit descended upon us as well when we were baptized.

PARISH REGISTRATION

All Parishioners 18 years and older are urged to register at the Church Office. The Parish is often expected to provide proof of Baptism, Confirmation, and other miscellaneous letters for individuals. This service is more easily and speedily rendered if the person is a registered, active and contributing member of our parish.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

INTERESTED IN THE CATHOLIC FAITH?

All persons wanting to learn more about the Catholic faith are invited to join the RCIA class. Practicing Catholics who want to become more knowledgeable in the faith are also invited. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process by which people become members of the Roman Catholic Church. Sessions are held on Tuesday evenings at 6:00 pm. Call the Parish Office at 340-774-0201 for class dates.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Please contact the priest 9-12 months in advance for pre-wedding counseling. A Wedding Handbook is available in the Parish Office which provides information on preparing for a Catholic marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK
