First Reading: Jeremiah 1:4-5, 17-19 The word of the Lord comes to Jeremiah.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 71 **“I will Sing of your Salvation.”**

Second Reading: 12:31-13:13 or 13:4-13 The greatest of these is love.

Gospel: Luke 4:21-30 “The people rise up to drive Jesus out of their town”

Jeremiah is called to preach God’s word, but most of the first reading describes God fortifying him against the opposition he will face. Jesus meets opposition from his hometown and needs to move on. But in between we are treated to Saint Paul’s rhapsody on love. The Corinthians were alternately jealous and dismissive of others’ spiritual gifts. Paul preaches that love is more important than any spiritual gift, for without love nothing else matters.

PARISH REGISTRATION

All Parishioners 18 years and older are urged to register at the Church Office. The Parish is often expected to provide proof of Baptism, Confirmation, and other miscellaneous letters for individuals. This service is more easily and speedily rendered if the person is a registered, active and contributing member of our parish.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

INTERESTED IN THE CATHOLIC FAITH?

All persons wanting to learn more about the Catholic faith are invited to join the RCIA class. Practicing Catholics who want to become more knowledgeable in the faith are also invited. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process by which people become members of the Roman Catholic Church. Sessions are held on Tuesday evenings at 6:00 pm. Call the Parish Office at 340-774-0201 for class dates.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Please contact the priest 9-12 months in advance for pre-wedding counseling. A Wedding Handbook is available in the Parish Office which provides information on preparing for a Catholic marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

Please contact the parish at any time if you or a loved one are hospitalized, confined to home or a nursing facility, or have some other emergency, and would like to receive the Eucharist and/or Anointing. Hospitals and healthcare facilities no longer routinely inform churches when a parishioner is admitted.

Se necesita valor, fuerza, gracia y auténtico compromiso para seguir al Señor. Escuchemos, con mucha atención, pero antes cantemos el Aleluya.
