REMEMBERING THE PAST
PARISHIONERS****Governor Cyril E. King (1921 to 1978)
First Lady Agnes A. Schuster-King
(1919 to 2003)**

The above 1977 photo was definitely the highlight of the King's diplomatic career that began after their 1946 wedding at Holy Cross Catholic Church, Christiansted, St. Croix and their successfully passed Civil Service exams a year later (1947) which earned them positions in Washington, D.C. at the American Veterans Committee.

Following the birth of their daughter Lillia, Mr. King joined the staff of Minnesota's freshman Senator, Hubert H. Humphrey (later US Vice President) and Mrs. Agnes Schuster-King passed more exams to qualify to work on several secret Federal Government projects at the Library of Congress just across the street from her husband.

Fourteen years later, the late President John F. Kennedy appointed Mr. King Government Secretary (in some States called Secretary of State and now locally called Lt. Governor); Mrs. King became the first native-born Second Lady. Fourteen years later, she became the second native-born First Lady.

It is important to note here that while in Washington, Mr. King stayed closely involved in the governmental workings of the US Virgin Islands which included assisting in the writing of the 1954 Revised Organic Act. Among their numerous accomplishments, both Governor and Mrs. King were honored Legislatively as follows:

PARISH REGISTRATION

All Parishioners 18 years and older are urged to register at the Church Office. The Parish is often expected to provide proof of Baptism, Confirmation, and other miscellaneous letters for individuals. This service is more easily and speedily rendered if the person is a registered, active and contributing member of our parish.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Baptisms are generally held on the last Sunday of the month. Requests for a different date and time will be honored to the extent possible. Parents and sponsors who have not yet received the required baptismal instruction are expected to do so by attending our baptismal preparation program. Call the Parish Office well in advance so that class arrangements can be made.

INTERESTED IN THE CATHOLIC FAITH?

All persons wanting to learn more about the Catholic faith are invited to join the RCIA class. Practicing Catholics who want to become more knowledgeable in the faith are also invited. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process by which people become members of the Roman Catholic Church. Sessions are held on Tuesday evenings at 6:00 pm. Call the Parish Office at 340-774-0201 for class dates.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Please contact the priest 9-12 months in advance for pre-wedding counseling. A Wedding Handbook is available in the Parish Office which provides information on preparing for a Catholic marriage.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING/MINISTRY TO THE SICK

A man of the people, a practicing catholic an attorney and a senator during his life.

A native of St Thomas VI he was educated in the public-school system and was a graduate of the CAHS. He earned his BA at New York University and his law degree from George Washington University School of Law in Washington DC

John Maduro was a Veteran, a musician who played in the community band, as well as a board member of the Magen's Bay Authority. He was committed to serving his community in all aspects. He entered the Senate race in 1958 won and served in the VI Legislature for eleven consecutive terms, he was a Senate President, Vice-President, Secretary as well as in many offices in the senate.

Moreover, as a practicing Catholic Senator, Attorney John Maduro contributed to his church in many ways, HE became a Knight of Columbus and earned several promotions within the organization. In fact, He rose to the fourth-degree Knight. Sir Knight, He served in the capacity of WORTHY GRAND KNIGHT.

Senator John Maduro was married to the former Claudia Hughes, a school nurse at CAHS for many years. She preceded him in death. Their union produced three children: CLAUDE, MABLE AND WINTHROP MADURO
