BLACK HISTORY MONTH REMEMBERING THE PAST PARISHIONERS

Gerard R. Nicholson (1923-2011)



Gerard (fondly known as Gerry) Ricardo Nicholson was born and raised on St. Thomas. His many career accomplishments included working for the U.S. Navy, owned and operated Caribbean Electric Co. & Caribbean Auto Sales, and being Executive Director of the VI Lottery. He met and married Aracely Garcia Romero in 1954 and God blessed them with four children (Lita, Gerard Jr., Carlos, & Judy).

Throughout his life Gerry was a devoted Catholic, serving and taking part in all aspects of the life of Sts. Peter & Paul Cathedral and Catholic School. His service included: Former Third Degree Knight of Columbus, president & member of the Parish Council, member of various advisory committees, lector, counter, and president of the School Board. Gerard received the Bishop's Award Sunday, September 8, 2002 from Bishop George V. Murry, S.J on behalf of the Catholic Church for his outstanding contributions. He continuously made significant donations to the Diocese, School, and the Cathedral's Restoration Fund to include the funding for the main entrance doors at Sts. Peter and Paul Cathedral.

Some of Gerry's other community services included; Chairman of the Board of the American Red Cross, member of the Chamber of Commerce, founding member of the Ramblers Club, and founding member of The Gypsy Carnival Troupe of 1952

His greatest joys were his service to his church, his love for his adoring family and being a kind heart, fun loving companion to his many friends.



José B. Kean (1920-1984)

Mr. Jose Kean was born on St. Thomas VI to Edmond E. & Natalie Kean on March 30, 1920. At an early age he started his musical training under the supervision of Miss Aimee Estornel, the principal organist of Saints Peter and Paul. He learned to play both the piano and organ. His love for music was such that over the years he excelled in playing several instruments to include the trombone, bass tuba, French horn, alto saxophone and percussion.

For most of his adult life, besides his work at a government agency, he played with the community band. Following the passing of Mr. David Monsanto, the band conductor, he became the new band

He was involved with many groups playing at hotels and clubs. Mr. Kean did not neglect his sons for he taught them and others the love of music and instructed them in the playing of instruments.

His religion was important to him. He was a faithful and regular attendee at masses, and was well known for his musical ability. Following the passing of Ms. Estornel, he became the organist and choir director of the church.

Mr. Kean continued for many years in that role, introducing new pieces and bringing additional members to the choir. When his health began to fail, he became unable to play music in his beloved church.
